3 General Rules for Junior, Elite and Veteran Tournament

The following rules and regulations will be applied:

1. The tournament is opened to **all** JKA organizations only
2. One country may several organisations and thus several teams
3. The age category is determined by the age of the contestant at the 1st day of the tournament
4. All Kumite matches will **Ippon shobu**; accurate technique (waza) and firm position are required
5. Arbitration of fouls in Junior Kumite matches are very strict in contrast to adult's matches
6. All countries are required to have effected payment of the registration and participation fees as per the imposed deadlines failing which they will not be allowed to participate to the tournament
7. Officially appointed doctors and medical aids will be present and administer first aids if need be
8. The doctors are the only decision-making authority to decide whether an injured contestant can continue or withdraw from the current match
9. If a doctor decides that a contestant must withdraw from the tournament, the latter will be disqualified and forbidden to perform during the rest of the tournament
10. All contestants are required to bring their own mandatory Kumite equipment (mouth piece, JKA approved white gloves and chest protection)
11. It is the **responsibility** of the contestant to take his or her own valid health insurance at competition date and to use same in case of injury
12. All matches will be arbitrated according to JKA Match Rules and Judge Regulations
13. Each country can register 1 Manager and up to 3 Coaches

14. Only the Registered Manager can officially file protests against decision of Judges
15. Each contestant must fill-in and sign the Consent Form failing which he or she will be disqualified from the tournament
16. The Registered Manager of each country is required to gather all duly signed consent forms and submit same to the Tournament Director as per the deadlines
17. All contestants must wear a white Karate-gi with the name or emblem of his or her country on the left side of the chest
18. All countries must attend the opening ceremony and bring their own **National Flag** of 180cm x 120 cm size
19. No change of contestant will be allowed after the closing of registration
20. No access will be allowed to the court area without a Tournament Identification Pass
21. Any contestant who registered to the junior competition cannot participate to the adults' tournament

Rules for individual kata boys and girls

Age divided in 11 categories

9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 ,17,18 and 19 to 21 years

For 9 to 12 years old

- Red and white tournament style from **first round to semi-finals**. Judges will choose randomly kata from Heian shodan up to Tekki shodan to select **the best 8 contestants**.
- The final will be between the best 8 contestants. **The point system** is applied to determine 1st, 2nd and 3rd place based on the best score.
- In this case, the contestants can choose among: Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Jion, Empi, Jitte, Hangetsu, and Gankaku
- In **case of tie**, the relevant contestant must engage in **an extra match** (Sai-shiai) both in red and white tournament style and point system.

For 13 to 21 years old

- Red and white tournament style from first round to the match to select **the best 16 contestants**
- **First and second round: Red and white flags**. Judges will choose randomly kata from Heian-shodan to Tekki-shodan
- **Third round: Red and white flags**. Judges will choose randomly kata from Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion

- **The Semi-final** is between 16 contestants: The **Point System** is applied to determine the best 8 Contestants who can choose among Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion
- **The Final** is between 8 contestants. The **Point System** is applied to determine the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place based on the best score. Contestants can choose their favourite Kata from: Jitte, Hangetsu, Gankaku, Tekki-nidan, Tekki-sandan, Bassai-sho, Kanku-sho, Nijushiho, Sochin, Meikyo, Gojushiho-dai, Gojushiho-sho, Unsu, Chinte and Wankan

Rules for individual jiyu kumite boys and girls (free sparing)

Age divided in 11 categories

9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 ,17,18 and 19 to 21 years

Ippon shobu system

- One point system (one Ippon or two Wazaari)
- Duration: 1minute and 30 seconds
- In **case of tie**, the relevant contestant must engage in an **extra match** Sai shi **SAKIDORI** Shobu (first one to place a point is the winner)
- There will be no Playoff round for the 3rd place (two 3rd place)
- All contestants (boys and girls) must wear a mouth piece and JKA officially approved white gloves and chest protector

5 Elite and Veteran Tournament Plan

Age divided in 4 categories

Elite: 22 to 39 years (one category)

Veteran: 40 – 49, 50 – 59 and 60+ above (three categories)

Rules for individual kata men and women

- Red and white tournament style from first round to the match to select **the best 16 contestants**
- **First and second round: Red and white flags.** Judges will choose randomly kata from Heian-shodan to Tekki-shodan
- **Third round: Red and white flags.** Judges will choose randomly kata from Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion
- **The Semi-final** is between 16 contestants: The **Point System** is applied to determine the best 8 Contestants who can choose among Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion
- **The Final** is between 8 contestants. The **Point System** is applied to determine the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place based on the best score. Contestants can choose their favourite Kata from: Jitte, Hangetsu, Gankaku, Tekki-nidan, Tekki-sandan, Bassai-sho, Kanku-sho, Nijushiho, Sochin, Meikyo, Gojushiho-dai, Gojushiho-sho, Unsu, Chinte and Wankan

Rules for individual kumite men and women

Ippon shobu system

- One point system (one Ippon or two Wazaari)
- Duration: 2 minutes from first round to final
- For the men's final, the duration is 5 minutes with 3 points system. The first contestant to obtain 2 Ippons (or 4 wazaari) shall be the winner
- In **case of tie**, the relevant contestant must engage in an **extra match Sai shi SAKIDORI** Shobu (first one to place a point is the winner)

- There will be no Playoff round for the 3rd place (two 3rd place)
- All contestants must wear a mouth piece and JKA officially approved white gloves
- Chest protector for women is **mandatory**

6 Team Tournament Plan

Rules for team kata men and team kata women

- Each team will be composed of 3 contestants only who must perform the same kata in synchronicity at once
- Contestants can choose their favourite Kata from: Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion, Jitte, Hangetsu, Gankaku, Tekki-nidan, Tekki-sandan, Bassai-sho, Kanku-sho, Nijushiho, Sochin, Meikyo, Gojushiho-dai, Gojushiho-sho, Unsu, Chinte and Wankan
- During the preliminary rounds, the **Point System** will be applied to determine the best 8 teams.
- The selected 8 teams must choose a different Kata for the Final (a kata different from the one they chose for the preliminary rounds)
- **The Final** is between 8 contestants. The **Point System** is applied to determine the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place based on the best score.
- In case of tie, the concerned contestants must engage in an **extra match** (Sai-shiai) with the same Kata
- If the extra match ends again with a tie, the lowest point will be added to the score to determine the **tiebreak**
- If the tiebreak score cannot determine the winner, then the highest point will be added to determine the **new tiebreak**
- In case the new tiebreak cannot determine the winner, the contestants must engage in an additional extra match with a **different Kata**

Rules for team kumite men and team kumite women

- Ippon Shobu system (one Ippon or two wazaari)
- Each team must be composed of 3 contestants only
- The duration of each kumite between 2 contestants of opposite team is 2 minutes
- Any contestant who loses two kumite on fouls will be disqualified and unable to continue the forthcoming rounds for his or her team
- All contestants must wear a mouth piece and JKA officially approved white gloves
- Chest protector for women is **mandatory**
- There will be a Playoff round to determine the 3rd place (one team 3rd place only)
